

Important Waterfront & Clubhouse Guidelines:

The Waterfront and our Clubhouse are a big part of what makes Oakledge special - in many ways, it's the heart of our community. We have put together a one-pager highlighting some of the important rules from the Greenbook that help keep our Waterfront & Clubhouse fun, safe & beautiful!

Waterfront:

- **Decks** - Decks can not be reserved. Please do not place personal items on decks/chairs and then leave the waterfront. Similarly, if you are going out on a boat or will be leaving for more than an hour, please move your stuff to the side so that others can use the deck.
- **Decks/Beach** - During the summer months if you have large gatherings at the waterfront, please try to use 1 deck and ensure that there is room on the beach for others.
- **Dogs/Pets** - Dogs should not be walked on the beach or swim off the beach. There is a swimming area and a deck where people can bring their dogs close to the West Dock. We ask that people share the dog deck in 1-2 hour increments so that everyone has an opportunity to enjoy the lake with their dogs. When using the dog swimming area, be respectful of our neighbors by keeping the noise level down. They are only feet away.
- **Glass** - Glass of any kind should not be used on the decks or beaches to avoid potential injuries caused by broken glass.
- **Toys** - The toy shed has great things for kids to play with. Please put all the toys back when you are finished playing.
- **Beach** - If there is significant digging done on the beach, please rake the beach and fill in the holes!
- **Broken Items** - Please report broken or missing items to the Harbormaster!

Boating/Paddleboarding:

- **Docks** - unless you have a permanent spot, the docks should be used for pick up and drop off only and for bathroom usage.
- **Paddleboards/Canoes/Kayaks** - we are fortunate to have community paddleboards, canoes and kayaks. Please treat them carefully, rack them when done using them and ensure paddles are returned and put back in the racks
- **Dinghies/Kayaks** - if you take a dinghy or kayak to get out to your boat, try and return it as quickly as possible so others can use it.

Clubhouse:

- **Game room** - please ensure that kids clean up after themselves and put things away when using the game room. Ping pong paddles, balls and pool cues are there for all to use, but need to be treated with respect.
- **Kitchen** - Please clean up after cooking and do not leave food in the refrigerators for more than a day or 2.
- **Lights** - in order to save electricity, please turn off lights when not in use.
- **Piano** - The piano, which may not be moved, is reserved for adults and children who are students of the piano.

Tennis Court:

- **Reserving the Court** - Please use the sign-up sheet to reserve the court. Players can reserve 90 minute slots.
